**"DAKOTA PRO AIR LLC"**

**WHEREAS**, Dakota Pro Air LLC, Huron, South Dakota, is requesting permission to operate, take off or land an aircraft on any county or township road in Beadle County, for the purpose of servicing said aircraft in preparation for aerial application of chemical or fertilizer materials, and

**WHEREAS**, Dakota Pro Air LLC has agreed to abide by the safety rules adopted by the Aeronautics Commission which is granted authority by subsections 2 and 3 of Section 70:02:02:08 of South Dakota Administrative Rule under the authority of SDCL 50-2-2.1 and assume all liability when using said roads, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** The Beadle County Commissioners in regular session this 28th day of March 2023 by unanimous vote, do hereby grant permission to Dakota Pro Air LLC to use said roads for requested use. Any signage that is removed/damaged will be replaced to county specifications.
